Rapidly changing technology and electronic devices improve our quality of life and business profitability. By recycling your electronic waste with Goodwill, you can trust that your goods will be processed using the highest standards for data security, worker health and safety, and environmental safety.

How it helps you:

Goodwill of Orange County provides secure destruction and recycling of your sensitive e-waste. We provide a certificate of destruction for every collection so you can be assured of the security of your business's information.

Every component of every computer is recycled. We provide a certificate of recycling for every collection for your use in meeting your company's and community's waste diversion goals. It also serves as your donation receipt for tax purposes.

How it helps the community:

By entrusting Goodwill of Orange County with your e-waste, you help Goodwill in its greater mission to provide opportunities for individuals with barriers to employment. We have special teams in our Recycling Department who excel at computer dismantling and hard drive destruction who would have limited success elsewhere. The proceeds from the sale of dismantled computers help to pay for all of the community outreach programs at Goodwill.

How it helps the environment:

Goodwill of Orange County only sells to documented, certified RIOS R2 and/or E-Steward recyclers, who meet stringent environmental, health and safety requirements of the US EPA. And by recycling, those recovered resources help meet the demand for new products, and take the strain off our planet's limited supply of natural resources.

Our Process:

- **Collection:** Depending on the size and need of your business, we can schedule regular collection or on-call pick-ups. When you have at least 20 items, including computers, monitors, faxes, printers, we can schedule pick up at your office at no charge.

- **Documentation:** Once your e-waste arrives at our warehouse, it is documented for weight and items, hard drives are pulled for destruction, and items including sensitive data are secured in a locked holding area.
- **De-manufacture:** Each day, our de-manufacturing team disassembles computers down to their component parts. These parts are then grouped together and sold for recycling and refurbishment.
- **E-stewards/R2 recyclers:** Goodwill of Orange County only sells to certified E-Stewards and RIOS R2 recyclers. These companies participate in a voluntary EPA-sponsored certification program that establishes environmental, health and safety in the absence of regulation in the U.S.

State and Federal Laws - E-waste in the waste stream: Prevent hazardous materials from ending up in the landfills.

SB20, SB 50, AB2901 were passed to keep electronics, including cell phones, tablets, and laptops, out of the landfills. By donating your electronic items to Goodwill, you comply with California State Laws regarding hazardous materials in the landfills.
