- Unlimited job coaching and on-the-job support
- Ongoing work-based vocational resources
- Work incentives and benefits planning
- Work experience opportunities

ELIGIBILITY/QUALIFICATIONS:

- Desire to work
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Receiving mental health services from within the Orange County Health Care Agency's network of care
- Provide proof of work eligibility and valid right-to-work documents
